The Pisa International Airport (Galileo Galilei) is about 2 km far from the **Pisa Centrale** train station, from which you can easily get to Lucca, Bagni di Lucca and to any other railway network destination in Tuscany and in Italy. Starting from March 18 2017, the airport and Pisa Centrale are connected by the PisaMover, the new and high-speed automated people mover service that runs every day from 6 a.m. to midnight, every 5/8 minutes.

The trip from the airport to the central station (and vice versa) aboard the **PisaMover** takes about 5 minutes. On the airport end of the route, you will find the stop at 40 metres from the Passenger Terminal (in via Pier Giorgio Ballini, to be more precise), while the train station stop is placed in correspondence of the former platform 14 (accessible through the underground pedestrian passageways of Pisa Centrale).






List of Speakers



Prof Ervin Laszlo is the President and Co-Founder of The Club of Budapest and the Founder of the Laszlo Institute of New Paradigm Research. He received the Sorbonne's Doctorat ès Lettres et Sciences Humaines in 1970. He lectured at various U.S. Universities including Yale and Princeton. Following his work on modeling the future evolution of world order at Princeton, he was asked to produce a report for the Club of Rome, of which he was a member. In the late 70s and early 80s, Laszlo ran global projects at the United Nations Institute for Training and Research at the request of the Secretary-General.

The author, co-author or editor of 90 books that have appeared in a total of 23 languages, Professor Laszlo has written several hundred papers and articles in scientific journals and popular magazines. He is a member of numerous scientific bodies, including the International Academy of Science, the World Academy of Arts and Science, the International Academy of Philosophy of Science, and the International Medici Academy. He was elected member of the Hungarian Academy of Science in 2010. The recipient of various honors and awards, including Honorary Ph. D.s from the United States, Canada, Finland, and Hungary, Laszlo received the Goi Award, the Japan Peace Prize in 2001, the Assisi Mandir of Peace Prize in 2006, and was nominated for the Nobel Peace Prize in 2004 and 2005.



Nitamo Montecucco

MD. PhD. Researcher in neuroscience and psychosomatic paradigm, expert in the treatment of psychophysical diseases. Co-Director and Dean of the Laszlo – Institute for New Paradigm Research Institute, Tuscany, Italy. Since 1991 he directs a team of doctors, psychologists, physicists, biologists, sociologists and teachers for the development of the new holistic paradigm, and of the neuroevolution of consciousness.

Since the 1989 he develops new scientific researches to psychosomatic health using advanced computerized electroencephalograph capable, through EEG coherence analysis He leads experiments on brain coherence, as a measure of psychosomatic integrity, studying normal people, psychiatric subjects in mental health hospitals as far as meditators in Himalayas and Indian spiritual centres. The researches on brain eeg coherence (synchronization) come publish in English on the scientific magazine " World future", on Italians, English and German magazines and broadcast on many television network: BBC, Swiss Television, Rai, Mediaset, TMC, etc.

Among the researches on coherence, one of the most important discoveries has been that the empathy between peoples is positively correlated to the electroencephalographic

coherence recorded between the same eeg points of the brains of a couple or of a group. The interpersonal electroencephalographic coherence seem to be a measure of the empathic communication level, to highlight the psychosomatics blocks and the intracerebral lack or excess of communication.

From 1999 to 2013 teaches psychosomatics and neuropsychology at the Master in Complementary Medicines of the University of Medicine of Milan, WHO (World Health Organization) Collaborating Center of Complementary Medicine. From 1996 to 2013 is the Director of the Psychosomatic PNEI Institute of the Global Village of Bagni di Lucca, where for over twenty years leads important research about the brain and EEG coherence in relation to psychological disease, meditation, empathy and neuropsychical resonance between people.



Simon Fox

Simon combines a background in music as a leading independent classical recording producer with intense involvement in the fields of health and Consciousness. He is the originator of a number of technologies relating to the transmission of Consciousness via sound, electromagnetic and scalar means. These culminate in his personal strengthening product, the Calmspace Pro, which has transformed the lives of many who are sensitive to manmade electromagnetic radiation, or who are concerned about its effects. Simon is passionate

about this topic, and considers that it extends beyond individual health concerns to the level that wireless communications are now destroying the integrity of DNA of all of life, and is interfering with humanity's ability to transcend its current level of awareness and consciousness.



Marcus Schmieke

The inventor of the information field technology and developer of TimeWaver systems was born in 1966. In the course of his studies of physics and philosophy in Heidelberg and Hanover, he developed the vision of exploring the interaction between matter and consciousness.

This synthesis between science and philosophy is the leitmotif in his life. Among other things, he has also studied Vedic philosophy and architecture during his stays in various Indian monasteries.

His encounter with the physicist Burkhard Heim, as well as his work on his own books about science and consciousness – The Last Secret and the Field of Life – laid the theoretical foundation for the development of Information Field technology. Through an intensive examination of Heim's model of the 12 dimensional structure of the universe, Marcus Schmieke gained a deep understanding of the physical Information Field.

Siegmur Gerken, Ph.D.,ECP, HP (Psychotherapy) studied psychology, education and anthropology. He has pioneered body-oriented and mindfulness-centered therapy and Humanistic, Somatic and Transpersonal Psychology since 1971. He is on the faculty of JFK University Somatic Psychology, at the Esalen Institute, Big Sur, California, taught at the Behavioral Therapy Training Institute Hamburg and teaches at universities and private institutes worldwide on the interconnectedness of psychosomatic processes as they manifest on the levels of body, emotions, mind, will and consciousness.

His research in energy field documentation with Prof. F. Popp on psycho-emotional states and the healing process opened new horizons to scientists and practitioners.



Ann Boone

Ann is an extraordinary healer and founder of the International Charity Relief from Pain.

After a 20 year corporate career, using her strong intuitive abilities, she is now focusing entirely on energy healing from her own practice in Maidenhead, near London. Having worked with more than a 1000 people has led her to create H.E.A.L., a personalised 7-step program. Most clients are dealing with severe grief after losing a spouse or parent. Other clients lose a child, born asleep, or due to an accident or illness.

Sometimes death is sudden and violent, sometimes chronic and exhausting. 
Carlo Ventura

Prof. Dr. Carlo Ventura received his M.D., the Ph.D. in Biochemistry and the Specialization in Cardiology from the University of Bologna, Italy. He spent several years at the Laboratory of Cardiovascular Sciences of the N.I.H./N.I.A. in Baltimore, USA. He is Full Professor of Molecular Biology and Director of the Experimental Cardiology Unit of the Institute of Cardiology at the University of Bologna, Italy. He is Scientific Director of the

“Stem Wave Institute for Tissue Healing (SWITH)” – Ettore Sansavini Health Science Foundation, and Gruppo Villa Maria (GVM) Care & Research (Lugo, Ravenna, Italy), the Division of Bologna of the National Institute of Biostructures and Biosystems (NIBB) (www.inbb.it), including the NIBB Research Units of Bologna, Firenze, and Siena, Italy, and The NIBB National Laboratory of Molecular Biology, at the S. Orsola – Malpighi Hospital of the University of Bologna, Italy.

In 2011, he founded VID art|science (www.vidartscience.org), an international movement promoting transdisciplinary approaches in Arts and Sciences. VID art|science encourages the common journey of Artists and Scientists to bring about a consciousness shift towards recognizing the inherent unity of Arts and Sciences, exploring the avant-garde of scientific innovation to unravel how human Arts may speak to the innermost dynamics of our biology to reawaken our self-healing potential.

At VID art|science Artists are evolving towards expressive forms autonomously inspired by a scientific landscape made of novel discoveries and paradigms. He devoted his studies to the molecular dissection of myocardial cell growth and differentiation, discovering nuclear endorphin receptors and signaling responsible for stem cell cardiogenesis. He developed new molecules with differentiating and paracrine logics for cardiovascular repair. He discovered the ability of electromagnetic fields to enhance stem cell pluripotency, and afford direct reprogramming of human dermal skin fibroblasts to myocardial, neuronal and skeletal muscle lineages. He showed that properly conveyed electromagnetic fields were able to revert stem cell senescence, disclosing novel perspectives in regenerative medicine. He found that stem cells are extremely sensitive to acoustic vibrational signatures. These findings paved the way to the use of physical energy in stem cell science.



Pier Mario Biava

Dr. Biava graduated in Medicine at the University of Pavia in 1969, specialised in Occupational Medicine at the University of Padova in 1972 and in Hygiene at the University of Trieste in 1977. He worked at the Institute of Occupational Medicine of University of Trieste, where he taught “Industrial Toxicology”, “Industrial Technology” and “Epidemiology of Occupational Diseases”. He has been studying environmental carcinogens since 1974. He has performed many epidemiological researches particularly about the relationship between asbestos and cancer.

He has been studying the relationships between stem cell differentiation and cancer since 1982 and he has isolated the stem cell differentiation stage factors able to delay tumor growth, to



prevent neurodegeneration and very effective in the treatment of psoriasis. Head of Occupational Medicine at the Hospital of Sesto S.G. (Milano) and Professor at the Post-Graduate School of Occupational Medicine of University of Trieste from 1984 until 2003, he works now at the Scientific Institute of Research and HealthCare (IRCS) Multimedica of Milano.

He is author of more than hundred scientific publications and of some books: "L'Aggressione Nascosta. Limiti Sanitari di Esposizione ai Rischi" published by Feltrinelli 1982, "Complexity and Biology" published by B. Mondadori 2002, " Il Cancro e la Ricerca del Senso Perduto" edited by Springer 2008, (this last book was published also in USA by North Atlantic Books 2009 (Cancer and the Search for Lost Meaning"), and by Verlag Via Nova in Germany 2011) and " Il Senso Ritrovato" (with Ervin Laszlo) published by Springer in 2012. With Ervin Laszlo and Diego Frigoli " he published the also the book: Dal Segno al Simbolo. Il Manifesto del Nuovo Paradigma in Medicina, edited by Persiani in 2014. He is member of Editorial Advisory Boards of some Scientific Journals.



Robert Williams

Robert is considered one of the world's foremost experts in subtle energy engineering and technology. Robert is an inventor, musician and educator. He lectures at leading universities and is the inventor and developer of Quantum Code Technology™. In addition to teaching music at the university level, Robert recorded and performed with such artists as The Beach Boys, Paul Horn and Charles Lloyd. He has worked with prominent scientists including Dr. William Tiller (Stanford),

Dr. Beverly Rubic (Berkeley), Dr. Rustum Roy (Penn State) and Dr. Stuart Krassner (UC Irvine).

At a young age, Williams had the ability to see auras and the capacity for clairvoyance. He tuned into the natural world the way not many others have. In *Love is the Power*, he shares a valuable message, simple yet necessarily vast to its core. The unfolding of his story is stirring and uplifting in its ability to relate to the reader in a way that finds beauty, depth and insight in even what seems the most trivial, or the most challenging life experiences.

The natural world was Williams' muse as a young child, connecting with nature spirits and a close spirit friend. With the onset of adolescence came the vanishing of these beings, resulting in Williams' anger, frustration and serious and mysterious physical ailments. Music became an unexpected replacement, as playing the saxophone was now an obsession. While in college he was deeply touched by a photo of Maharishi Mahesh Yogi that would forever change the course of his life. He decided to attend Maharishi International University in Iowa.

Williams' extraordinary talent playing the saxophone eventually landed him his dream job of touring with The Beach Boys. Williams' search for spirituality reached a pivotal moment when he learned that despite years of dedication to the saxophone, a physical disability would prevent him from playing the instrument he loved for extended periods of time. It was his search for the rekindling of the spirituality of his childhood and his love of music, the "carrier waves of pure heart love," that led him to discover TM. This

discovery was crucial to the events that would happen next: nearly dying multiple times, clear vision and communication with his guru, revelations of sacred geometry, and travels through the dimensions. Vera Brandes - Biography

Vera Brandes is Director of the Research Program for Music-Medicine at Paracelsus Medical University, Salzburg, Austria and co-founder, CEO and CSO of SANOSON in Vienn. She is Vice President of IAMM (International Association for Music and Medicine), New York, USA, board member of I.M.A.R.A.A. (International Music and Arts Research Association Austria), program council to the Human Health Project and member of numerous scientific advisory boards. She is also a certified music therapist registered with the Federal Ministry of Health, Austria.

Since 1995, she has been committed to the integration of music in medical therapy and prevention. Since 1999 she organized advanced trainings for medical doctors and therapists in Neurodevelopmental Auditory Training. From 2001 to 2003, she lectured on culture & media at the University for Applied Sciences in Salzburg, Austria. She co-initiated and co-organized the congress “in:fusion – New Qualities in Healthcare” in 2004 before she assumed her current position at the Paracelsus Medical University. She is also CSO of SANOSON in Vienna, Austria and developed sanumeda, a patient dedicated hospital radio channel (in close cooperation with Tom Doch) and I-MAT© (Individualized Music-focussed Audio Therapies) for the treatment of psychosomatic disorders.

She has published numerous articles, and presents at international conferences. Before she began her career in science, Brandes was an award-winning music producer and record company owner. Between 1974 and 1999 she released more than 350 CDs featuring a broad spectrum of international artists and promoted a multitude of concerts, tours and festivals.

Dieter Broers - Biography

He is a German biophysicist, author and film producer. He studied physics and electrical engineering at the University of Hamburg.

Dieter Broers has been conducting research in the field of frequency medicine and regulation therapy since the 1980s and has earned patents in eight-five countries. From 1987 to 1992, he led an interdisciplinary research project (“Bio-Impulse Field Oscillator”) funded by Germany’s Federal Ministry for Research and Technology. The study’s groundbreaking findings were used for the development of new therapeutic devices and represented a significant advancement in medical research. Since 1997, he has been a biophysics director at the International Council for Scientific Development

(ICSD), whose members include one hundred Nobel Prize winners.

Over the years, Broers’s research led him to the science of consciousness. His model is based on advanced biophysics describing a holistic world view in which matter and consciousness are inseparable. Broers’s books and films i.e the award winning documentary Solar Revolution (2012) continue to have a significant impact in the German-speaking countries, France, the USA and in Russia. With the release of his book The Matrix Code, he began his career as a best-selling author in Germany. His 13th book will be published in the fall of 2017. Dieter Broers currently lives and works in Austria and Greece.



Manetti Ceschi a Santa Croce – Biography
